PROPOSAL: Determine that Proposed Amendments to Rule 1403 - Asbestos Emissions from Renovation/Demolition Activities are Exempt from CEQA and Amend Rule 1403

Staff is recommending that the public hearing on this item be withdrawn from consideration.

SYNOPSIS: Proposed amendments to Rule 1403 will provide revisions to further clarify existing rule requirements, enhance enforceability, and align the requirements with the applicable U.S. EPA NESHAP and with other state and local agency regulations. The proposed amendments include clarifying who is covered by the rule, standard and emergency notification procedures, specifying information to be included in survey reports, and reinforcing minimum sampling requirements for determining whether materials are asbestoscontaining. This action is to adopt the Resolution: 1) Determining that the proposed amendments to Rule 1403 - Asbestos Emissions from Renovation/Demolition Activities are exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act; and 2) Amending Rule 1403 - Asbestos Emissions from Renovation/Demolition Activities.
