- Will present to Governing Board on October 2, 2015 with 7 other white papers

Revisions based on stakeholder feedback

1. Add more stationary source examples

- a. We provide two additional examples for stationarysource facilities (p. 12)
 - Targeted Air Shed Grants
 - ii. High Volume Low Pressure spray guns
- b. We highlight SCAQMD rules 219 & 222 which reward low-emission sources with streamlined permitting process or permit exemption (p. 10)
- c. We point readers to the 'Industrial Facility Modernization' White Paper which further explores business cases for stationary sources (p. 2)

Revisions based on stakeholder feedback

2. Discuss macroeconomic conditions

- a. We give an economic snapshot of the goods movement sector in the Basin and highlight the importance of the sector to the regional economy (in addition to the original discussion of why NOx reductions in this sector are crucial to attain federal clean air standards) (p. 2)
- b. We clarify that an extensive socioeconomic analysis will be conducted in the upcoming AQMP to address regional economic impacts. (p. 9)
