18 The parties, the South Coast Air Quality Management District (“South Coast AQMD”
19 or “Respondent”) and County of San Bernardino – Fleet Management (“SB County” or
20 “Petitioner”) do hereby stipulate and agree as follows:

21 1. This matter may be placed on the Hearing Board’s Consent Calendar to be heard on
22 October 15, 2024, pursuant to District Hearing Board Rule 4(a)(4);

23 2. The Petitioner seeks a Interim Variance from the provisions of South Coast
24 AQMD Rule 203(b) for the specific permit condition listed in the attached (Proposed) Order.

25 3. The Declaration of Lauren Doucette (filed concurrently as Exhibit 1 to this
26 Stipulation) and the September 7, 2024 Proclamation of a State of Emergency (filed concurrently
27 as Exhibit 2 to this Stipulation) may be submitted to the Hearing Board and entered into evidence

1 in support of Petitioner’s Findings and Order (Stipulated);

2 4. The parties request the Hearing Board to decide this matter based upon the
3 documents submitted by the parties, before the Hearing Board of the South Coast Air Quality
4 Management District; the Declaration of Lauren Doucette, and Proposed Findings, Decision and
5 Order.

6 5. The parties have agreed on the proposed Findings and Decision and Proposed
7 Order (filed concurrently with Stipulation) which may be submitted to the Hearing Board in
8 support of the Petition for an Interim Variance;

9 6. The parties agree that the granting of the Interim Variance under the Proposed
10 Order is not expected to result in a violation of Health and Safety Code Section 41700.

11 7. The South Coast AQMD does not oppose the Petitioner’s request for the
12 granting of the Interim Variance for the Petitioner.

13 8. Based on all of the evidence in this case, the parties stipulate the Hearing Board
14 decide this matter on the Consent Calendar.
