Procedural & Factual Background

B. Braun Medical Inc. ("BMI") filed the Variance Petition on November 3, 2023, seeking relief from Rule 1134, which, as of January 1, 2024, lowered the nitrogen oxide ("NOx") emissions limit applicable to two critical cogeneration turbines (the "Cogens" or "Turbines") operated at BMI's facility located at 2525 McGaw Avenue in Irvine, California (the "Irvine Facility"). BMI sought the Variance in order to allow additional time to complete installation of two Bloom Energy ("Bloom") solid oxide fuel cell systems (the "Fuel Cells") at the Irvine Facility, and decommissioning of the Cogens. The Fuel Cells will replace the Cogens and provide the Facility with a critical, dependable source of power for its medical manufacturing operations.

Once the Fuel Cells are operational, the Irvine Facility will be compliant with Rule 1134. For additional information on the Fuel Cells project and the Irvine Facility's efforts to comply with Rule 1134, see
