


1 2. I graduated with a B.S. in Chemical Engineering from the University of California, Irvine

3 before that. My current responsibilities at SCE include overseeing Air Quality matters for the
4 PBGS Repower project, including the Permit to Construct process. I also supervise the portable
5 generator program across SCE's service territory. Before joining SCE, I worked at Marathon
6 Petroleum starting in 2015, where I managed the Los Angeles Refinery's Greenhouse Gas, source
7 testing, Title V, and emissions inventory programs. Prior to Marathon Petroleum, I worked for
8 Valero Energy Corporation at the Wilmington Refinery, where I managed all required emission
9 inventory programs.
