




AGRICULTURAL BURN ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

Fire Dept Requirement

Area surrounding the burn piles must be cleared to "bare" mineral soil

Minimum distance between burn piles is 30 feet. Burn piles to any power lines or affected property lines is 100 feet

Allowable pile size is 20 feet diameter by 15 feet high.










HOW WE DETERMINE TREATED WOOD WASTE





OBTAINING A BURN PERMIT

Schedule inspection with SCAQMD

Complete application form and fee

Obtain a SCAQMD Burn Permit

Obtain a Fire Dept Permit

Call Burn
Line the day
before to
obtain a Burn
Authorization
Number

Call FD on morning of the burn for authorization

Allowed Burn Hours

1 hour after sunrise until no later than 2 hours before sunset

7:00 am - 5:00 pm





Assembly Bill (AB) 617 Community Air Protection Program - Eastern Coachella Valley

Rule 444 Open Burning minimizes

emissions from open burning to protect public health and safety.

This rule applies to:













Agricultural Burning Requirements

Agricultural burning:

reduce fire hazard

- must be at least 1,000 feet away from homes, schools daycare centers, and
- must begin one hour after sunrise and be finished two hours before sunset

to be burned

. Fruit bearing trees

· Date palm froncis

- · must be less than 47 acres per day · must contain only agricultural
- waste (free of dirt, soil, and other debris
- · must be lit with an approved device (does not produce black smake)

After receiving a Burn Authorization Number, contact your he morning of the burn to see if burning

Waste NOT allowed

- · Pallets, chamically treated wood
- · Pesticide and fertilizer
