Thank you for your participation in the Community Air Protection (CAP) Program and your continued commitment to protect California's citizens and air quality. The purpose of this letter is to inform you that California Air Resources Board (CARB) staff have approved the following modified community-identified project plan:

 Paving Project Plan, (2022-19CIP-SC-2): This modification increases the awarded grant amount for non-construction costs to 25% and allows the air district to pursue other mechanisms to execute a contract including, but not limited to, a request for quotes (RFQ), program announcement (PA), sole-source contract, or memorandum of understanding (MOU) in the event the PA does not result in an executed contract.

This approval allows South Coast Air Quality Management District to implement this measure as outlined in the Community Emission Reduction Program for Eastern Coachella Valley. Enclosed is a copy of the approval notice that will be posted on CARB's website. Please also post the approval notices to your website, inform CARB staff of the link location, and include approved project plans in the air district's Policies and Procedures for CAP Incentives Guidelines.
