- Warehouse Operations Notification (Sept 1, 2021)
- First Compliance Period for Warehouses \geq 250,000 sq. ft.
(Jan 1, 2022 – Dec 31, 2022)



- CARB staff to review and approve






INCENTIVE FUNDING – NEXT STEPS

INCENTIVE FUNDING – PUBLIC PROCESS

What is a Particle?

Facts:

- Particle pollution is a complex mixture of extremely small solid and liquid components
- Made up of many different materials such as dust, pollen, & metals
- Either directly emitted from a source like a smokstack or forms through reactions with other substances in the air
- Vary tremendously in size: PM_{2.5}, PM₁₀. (See diagram to right)
- If you can see a particle, its diameter is greater than 50 microns. These large particles are generally filtered out by our noses before they get into our lungs
- There are 25,400 microns in one-inch
