Meeting Summary

The tenth AB 617 Community Steering Committee Meeting for the San Bernardino, Muscoy community took place at the San Bernardino Valley College on October 17, 2019. Angelica Balderas, the meeting co-host, opened with housekeeping items and asked for volunteers to provide community testimony. Daniel Wong (Public Senior Information Specialist, South Coast AQMD) and Mary Valdemar (CSC member) summarized the highlights from the community tour. Diana Thai (Program Supervisor, South Coast AQMD) provided a recap on the adoption of the Community Emissions Reduction Plan at the South Coast AQMD Governing Board Meeting and explained the next steps for California Air Resources Board (CARB). She explained that CARB staff will hold a community meeting to hear from the community and David Salardino (Program Supervisor, CARB) specified that the meeting will be held in Los Angeles.

Terrance Mann (Assistant Deputy Executive Officer in the Enforcement and Compliance Division, South Coast AQMD) went over truck idling regulations and enforcement efforts on truck idling sweeps. CSC members asked about the idling sweep process and details about the truck idling regulation. CSC members also asked how to file complaints and about the process for issuing a violation. Angelica Balderas continued the meeting by introducing the truck idling prioritization activity. CSC members were given a booklet of maps with truck idling locations that the CSC identified in past meetings. CSC members had the opportunity to use the worksheet to provide detailed information on the locations and the time and day(s) when suspected idling occurs. After the activity concluded, Angelica Balderas introduced Vicki White (Technology Implementation Manager, South Coast AQMD) who provided a summary on the AB 617 incentive fund projects, a background on AB 134, Senate Bill (SB) 856, and upcoming funding opportunities. She welcomed suggestions to improve outreach strategies for incentives. CSC members asked questions about how funding is granted, how the truck survey is conducted, the application process, and future funding opportunities.

Payam Pakbin (Program Supervisor in the Advanced Monitoring Technologies Division, South Coast AQMD) provided an update on the monitoring efforts deployed in the community. This included mobile air monitoring for black carbon near the BNSF railyard, volatile organic compounds (VOCs) near Omnitrans, and particulate matter (PM10) and hexavalent chromium (Cr6+) near concrete batch plants. CSC members asked questions about the monitoring process and logistics, data visualization, monitoring station locations, potential considerations for health thresholds and follow-up monitoring activities. CSC members also expressed concern regarding the data collected and suggested comparing it to data from communities without major air pollution sources. Diana Thai provided examples of actions beginning in 2020 for the community emissions reduction plan (CERP) implementation. Daniel Wong also asked CSC members to submit an interest form if they were interested in recommitting to the CSC for next year. Angelica Balderas announced important reminders and deadlines including future meeting details and agenda items.
