## <u>Categorical Exemption for CUP-14-003 – Wireless Communication Facility</u>

The South Coast Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD) staff appreciates the opportunity to comment on the above-mentioned project both as a commenting agency and a responsible agency. The following comments are meant as guidance for the Lead Agency.

In the project description, the Lead Agency proposes to install, operate and maintain a new 60-foot tall monopalm wireless telecommunications facility comprised of 12 panel antennas and the construction of a new 225 square foot equipment enclosure. If the proposed project includes a diesel-fueled generator which is rated greater than 50 brake horsepower (bhp), a permit would be required in accordance with SCAQMD rules including Rule 1470 – Requirements for Stationary Diesel-Fueled Internal Combustion and Other Compression Initial Engines and Rule 1110.2 – Emissions From Gaseous- and Liquid-Fueled Engines. If there are permit questions concerning the generator, they can be directed to Engineering and Compliance Staff at (909) 396-2315.
