**Proposed Installation, Use and Maintenance of a Wireless Telecommunications Facility Project at
36211 Champions Dr, Beaumont, CA 92223 (15-CUP-07)**

The South Coast Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD) staff appreciates the opportunity to comment on the above-mentioned project. The following comments are meant as guidance for the Lead Agency.

In the project description, the Lead Agency proposes the installation, operation, and maintenance of a disguised wireless telecommunication facility that includes the installation of a 60 inch monopine to include 12 panel antennas and two parabolic antennas in a 100-square-foot tower lease area. If the proposed project includes a diesel-fueled generator which is rated greater than 50 brake horsepower (bhp), a permit would be required in accordance with SCAQMD rules including Rule 1470 – Requirements for Stationary Diesel-Fueled Internal Combustion and Other Compression Initial Engines and Rule 1110.2 – Emissions From Gaseous- and Liquid-Fueled Engines. If there are permit questions concerning the generator, they can be directed to Engineering and Compliance Staff at (909) 396-2315.
