## **Draft Removal Action Workplan (RAW) for Southern California Edison San Jacinto**

South Coast Air Quality Management District (South Coast AQMD) staff appreciates the opportunity to provide comments on the above-mentioned document. The purpose of the Draft RAW is to develop cleanup actions to remove soil contaminated with polychlorinated biphenyls, arsenic, and lead on a 0.14-acre site (site) that is located on the southwest corner of South San Jacinto Avenue and East Third Street in the City of San Jacinto. Polychlorinated biphenyls, arsenic, and lead are among the applicable toxic air contaminants listed in South Coast AQMD Rule 1466 – Control of Particulate Emissions from Soils with Toxic Air Contaminants<sup>1</sup>. Therefore, it is recommended that the Final RAW includes clarification on whether Department of Toxic Substances Control, or other agencies listed in Rule 1466(b), have designated, or plan to designate, the cleanup site for the contaminants listed as a concern. Additionally, if the site is so designated and thus subject to South Coast AQMD Rule 1466 requirements, it is recommended that applicable Rule 1466 requirements be incorporated into the Final RAW.
