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Class 1 Permit Modification for DeMonno-Kerdoon

South Coast Air Quality Management District (South Coast AQMD) staff appreciates the opportunity to provide comments on the above-mentioned document. According to the Public Notice of Class 1 Permit Modification, the Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) is evaluating modifications to an existing hazardous waste facility permit to decommission the pugmill and remove its reference from the permit for DeMonno-Kerdoon that is located at 2000 North Alameda Street on the southeast corner of North Alameda Street and East Pine Street in the City of Compton. Since the pugmill is a facility component, decommission and removal of the pugmill need to comply with U.S. Code of Federal Regulations Title 40 Chapter 61 Subpart M National Emission Standard for Asbestos¹ and South Coast AQMD Rule 1403 – Asbestos Emissions from Demolition/Renovation Activities².
