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Removal Action Workplan for Jordan High School

South Coast Air Quality Management District (South Coast AQMD) staff appreciates the opportunity to provide comments on the above-mentioned document. The Draft Removal Action Workplan proposes excavation and off-site disposal of soil impacted with chlordane, an organochlorine pesticide that is within and around buildings at Jordan High School. If Jordan High School was identified with contaminant(s) of concern at the site and has been designated and notified by an applicable agency per Rule 1466(d)(1), remedial actions should comply with requirements of South Coast AQMD Rule 1466 – Control of Particulate Emissions from Soils with Toxic Air Contaminants¹ for excavating, grading, handling, and treating Applicable Toxic Air Contaminant(s) in soils. Therefore, it is recommended that the Final Removal Action Workplan include a discussion of Rule 1466 requirements.
