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Draft Interim Measures Workplan for Angeles Chemical Company, Inc.

South Coast Air Quality Management District (South Coast AQMD) staff appreciates the opportunity to provide comments on the above-mentioned document. Based on the Community Update, the Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) is proposing to install and operate a soil vapor extraction (SVE) system to clean up soil contaminated with volatile organic compounds (VOCs) on the Angeles Chemical Company, Inc. site (Site). The Site is located at 8915 Sorensen Ave, Santa Fe Springs, CA.

Due to the presence of VOCs in soil, requirements of South Coast AQMD Rule 1166 – Volatile Organic Compound Emissions from Decontamination of Soil¹ will apply and should be discussed in the final workplan. A Rule 1166 compliance plan will be required. Additionally, since the proposed remedial actions would involve the installation and use of a SVE system, complete and timely permit applications for a Permit to Construct and a Permit to Operate for the SVE system will be required under South Coast AQMD Rule 201 – Permit to Construct² and Rule 203 – Permit to Operate³.
