Statement of Basis for Rainbow Transport Tank Cleaners Site Project

South Coast Air Quality Management District (South Coast AQMD) staff appreciates the opportunity to provide comments on the above-mentioned document. Based on the Community Update, the Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) is developing remedial actions to complete groundwater monitoring, install a soil vapor extraction (SVE) system, establish a land use covenant to restrict future land uses to commercial and industrial uses, and implement a soil management plan on a 10-acre site (Site). The Site is located at 21119 South Wilmington Avenue near the southwest corner of South Wilmington Avenue and East Dominguez Street in the City of Carson within the designated AB 617 Wilmington, Carson, West Long Beach community. Since the remedial actions would involve installation and operation of a SVE system, complete and timely permit applications for a Permit to Construct and a Permit to Operate for the SVE system will be required under South Coast AQMD Rule 201 – Permit to Construct¹ and Rule 203 – Permit to Operate².
