



### Proposed Amended Rule 314

- 🔧 Exempt small manufacturers from fees
  - <1,000 gallons annual sales and <0.5 tons VOC emissions ✔️
- 🔧 Enhance Implementation
  - Remove grouping provision ❌
  - Add requirement for ‘Big Box’ Retailers to also submit report to District, include list of stores ✔️
  - Remove outdated Phased-in Fee Rate

## Proposed Amendments Rule 314

 Include private labelers in Applicability 

 Add 5 definitions from Rule 1113

- Multi-Component Coating 
- Post-Consumer Waste
- Recycled Coating
- Secondary Coatings
- Stationary Structure

## Proposed Amendments Rule 314

 Add 4 New Definitions

- Authorized Representative 
- Concentrates 
- Private Labeler 
- Toll Manufacturer

 Amend 5 New Definitions

- Aerosol Coating Product 
- Architectural Coatings
- Architectural Coatings Manufacturer
- Formulation Data
- Responsible Party  included most of the suggested language

## Proposed Amendments Rule 314

 Clarification on delegation and changes to Authorized Representative and Responsible Party 

 Add flag for:

- Stains and lacquers sold above 4,000 feet
- *No longer proposing flags for multi-component coatings or concentrates*

 Clarification for reporting requirements when there are 'no sales'

## Proposed Amendments Rule 314

 Exemptions

- Amend fee exemption for recycled coatings and coatings containing less than 5 g/L material
- Exempt coatings sold as a dry mix, containing no polymer content, that is solely mixed with water, e.g. stucco

## Proposed Amended Rule 314

### Issue

-  Industry request to retain the ability to group coatings
- Confidentiality concerns
- Multiple colors

### Response

-  Compliance not verifiable for grouped products
-  Audits reveal issues with grouping
-  District protects the confidentiality of sales data
-  Publically searchable database functionality enhanced

## Proposed Amended Rule 1113

-  Exempt sample containers from labeling ( $\leq 2$  oz) 

- **Per industry's suggestion, changed exemption to all labeling**

### Other Clarifications

- Multi-component coatings 
- Concentrates 
- Colorants 
- Rules 1143/1171 Applicability - **created new section per industry's suggestion** 
- Remove outdated language
- Add SIP Approved Test Method 313

# Revised Laboratory Method 313

- 🧪 Updated Equipment
- 🧪 Enhanced quality control
- 🧪 Inclusion of an endpoint (Methyl Palmitate)

30 day comment period on the draft Method

# PAR 1113 Small Container Labeling

- Industry request - exempt 2 oz containers 🟢 Agree
- Subsequent request by some manufacturers to exempt up to 8 oz containers
  - Some manufacturers already comply
  - 8 oz containers include more than just sample size

## Proposed Amended Rule 1113

### Issue

- Industry request sell through for labeling

### Response

- 30 months provided in Board adopted rule
- Numerous manufacturers already comply

## Proposed Amended Rule 1113

### Issue

- Don't add Method 313
- May overestimate semi-volatiles


### Response

- Superior to Method 24 for low-VOC formulation
- Used for 15+ years
- ACA and others have asked for inclusion previously
- Similar method (ASTM D6886) used by industry and academia
- Tethered to Method 24
- USEPA Feedback – semi-volatiles on a case by case basis
