South Coast Air Management District Governing Board,

I urge you to enact strict enforceable Indirect Source Review rules for rail yards that will reduce the amount of pollution they cause.

The transportation sector is a major source of greenhouse gases and air pollution. For example, In the Los Angeles region, it is responsible for producing 85% of the key contributor to smog. Within that sector, the largest polluters in the air basin are the trucks, ships and locomotives that move in and out of our ports and rail yards. The pollutants cause lung ailments, cardiovascular disease and premature death. The pollution especially affects community members who live close to ports, rail yards, warehouses, and freeways.

Please, improve air quality and health by passing Indirect Source Review rules that will significantly reduce the pollution caused by freight rail yards.
